>> Cart golf: A few years ago, Sun Mountain scored a surprise hit with the Speed Cart, a lightweight, collapsible push cart. Now the Missoula, Mont., company is back with the Speed E Cart, an electric, self-propelled version.

The front wheel of the three-wheel cart conceals a silent, 24-volt motor that is controlled by buttons on the handle, though it also can be pushed with the motor off. The Speed E Cart weighs 31 pounds, and the battery 11 pounds.

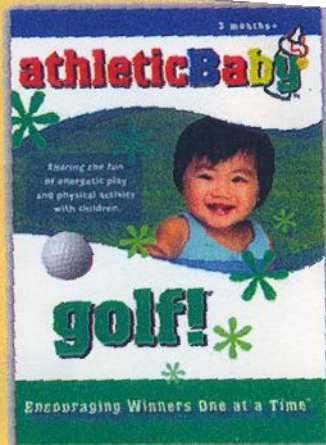
